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VACANCY — VOLUNTEER TEACHER

The Girl Child Network is an independent, non-political, non-religious, not-for-profit organization working to improve the status of children in Kenya with an emphasis on the girl child. The organization is implementing inclusive education projects to improve school enrolment, retention, attendance and learning outcomes for learners with disabilities in Kenya. Girl Child Network invites suitably qualified and experienced candidates to join our dynamic team as a volunteer teacher.

Roles and responsibilities

The volunteer teacher will be responsible for teaching students with special needs at an identified public primary school in Nairobi County. They will also participate in assessment activities to identify learners with special needs and school-wide programs to promote inclusion. They will receive training in ABA therapy, verbal behavior assessment, and data-driven instruction. The period of engagement will be for three (3) months, beginning in January 2019, with the potential for renewal based on performance.

- Experience working with children with disabilities

- Computer literacy
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Understanding of laws and policies related to child protection and education
- Commitment to the rights of children with disabilities and a high level of personal integrity
